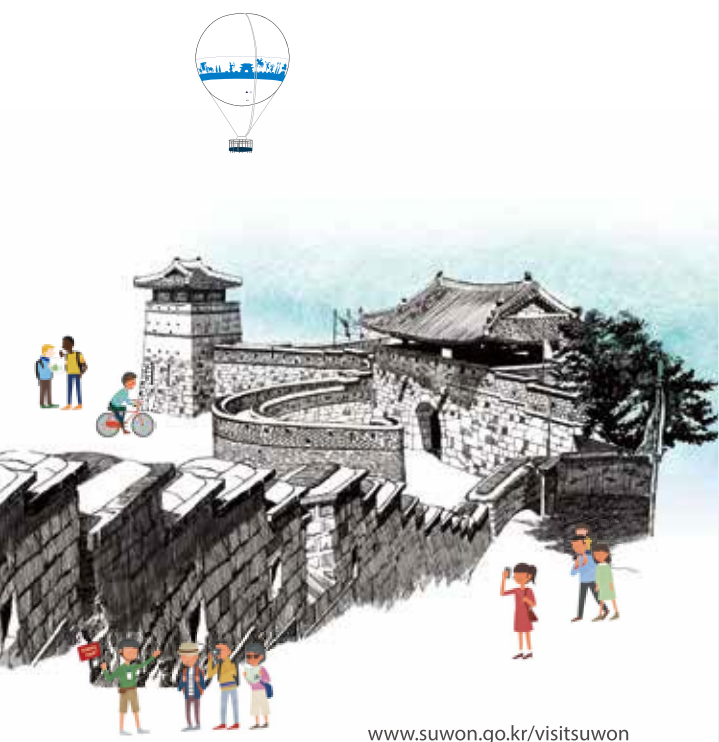

## Suwon Hwaseong Day Tour Course

**Depart at the parking lot of Hwaseong Haenggung Palace!**

**11:00**  
Enjoy the 24 Martial Arts Performance  
Watch exciting martial arts performed with real swords and take pictures with Joseon Dynasty warriors.

**11:30**  
Tour Hwaseong Haenggung Palace  
The palace is where King Jeongjo, who built Suwon Hwaseong Fortress, stayed during his visits to Suwon. Learn about the deep filial piety he had for his mother Hyegyeong Hong.

**12:30**  
Enjoy Chimac at Fried Chicken Street soondaejuk (soup with Korean blood sausage) at Jidong Soondae Town  
Try the cold beer and crispy chicken of Fried Chicken Street, or the fried soondae or savory soondae stew of Jidong Soondae Town.

**14:00**  
Visit Suwon I'Park Museum of Art  
An art center boasting modern architecture! Don't miss out on a chance to view the various featured exhibitions!

**Ride on the Hwaseong Royal Train**  
You can also take the sightseeing tour that goes around Suwon Hwaseong Fortress starting from Hwaseong Haenggung Palace. The train is operated at 30-minute intervals.

**15:00**  
Experience traditional Korean archery at Yeonmudae Command Post  
Enjoy traditional Korean archery for just 2,000 KRW! People of all ages can try it. It's fun enough to make you try another shot!

**16:00**  
Tour Suwon Hwaseong Fortress  
This is where the real tour of Suwon Hwaseong Fortress starts! Recommended places nearby are Changnyongmun Gate, Dongbuk Gongsimdon, Dongginsdae Command Post, Banghwasuryong (Dongginsdae Pavilion and Hwahongmun (Buksumun) Gate). It is not too difficult to get as far as Jangnamun Gate.

**17:30**  
Walk from Hwahongmun (Buksumun) Gate to the parking lot of Hwaseong Haenggung Palace  
Distance : about 800m

**18:30**  
Enjoy Suwon beef ribs

## Four Major Tour Spots in Suwon Brimming with Things to Enjoy

### 1 Suwon Hwaseong Fortress

Suwon Hwaseong Fortress, a World Heritage Site, is Suwon's representative tourist spot that is overflowing with things to enjoy with the touch of King Jeongjo. There are Hwaseong Haenggung Palace, a museum, an art center, and Craft Street nearby.

### 2 Dongsuwon

Around Dongsuwon IC and Gwanggyo Sanghyeon IC, the major entrances to Suwon, are museums of varying themes as well as Gwanggyo Lake Park and Gwanggyosan Mountain.

### 3 Around Suwon City Hall

Satisfy your appetite on Rha Hye-suk Street lined with marvelous things to eat, and take a light stroll at Wolhwawon Garden, which looks like a Chinese garden.

### 4 Seosuwon

This zone is like a delicacy of tourism in Suwon. The wide-opened waterside spaces Changnangje and Manseogseo are scenic reservoirs built by King Jeongjo hundreds of years ago.

#### Hwaseong Royal Train

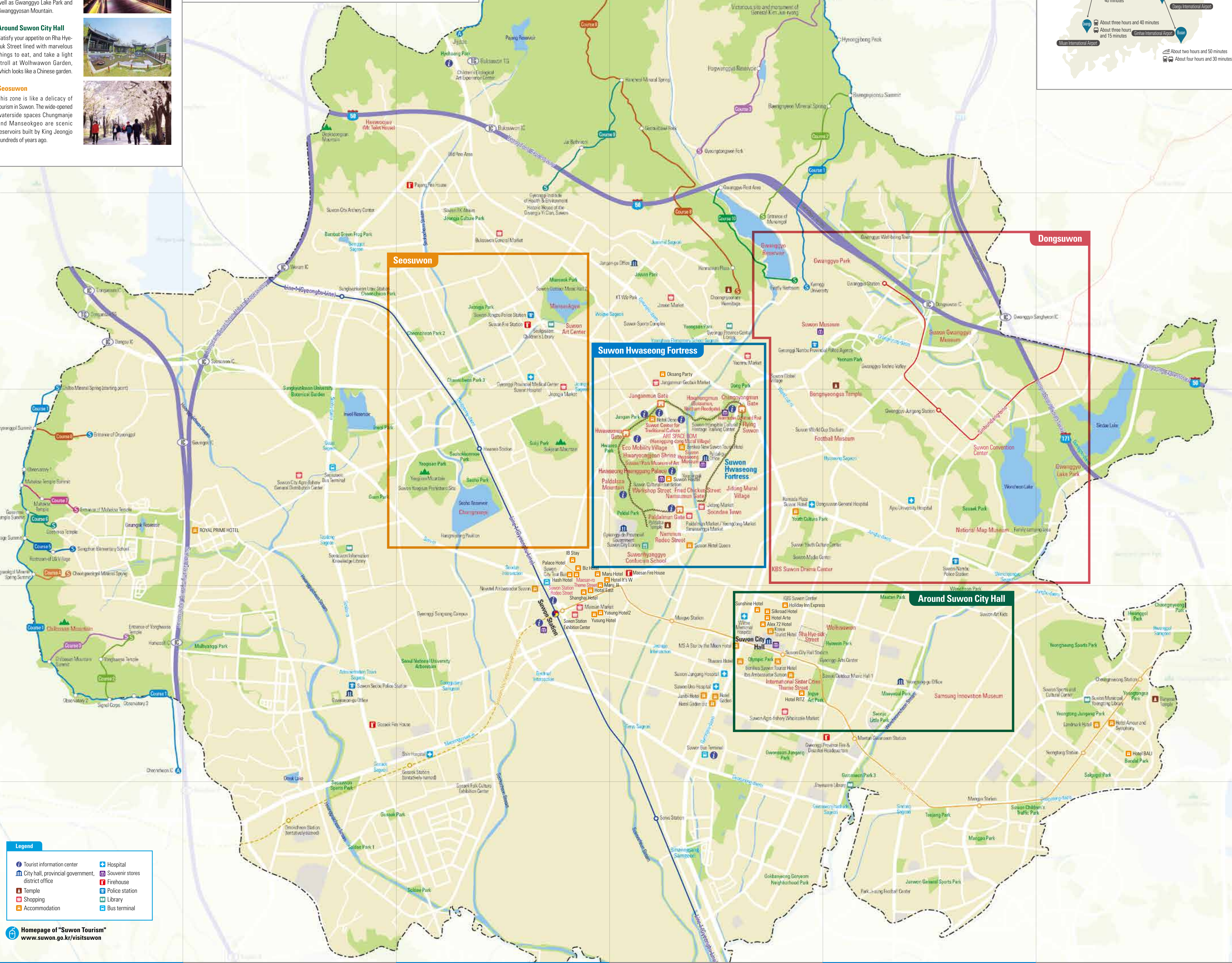
(Get on at Hwaseong Haenggung Fortress or Yeonmudae)  
Hwaseong Royal Train is the most comfortable way to tour Suwon Hwaseong Fortress. Explore every corner of Suwon Hwaseong Fortress as if you're a king.

#### Flying Suwon (Ride at: Changnyongmun Gate)

Get a spectacular aerial view of Suwon Hwaseong Fortress from the sky. Flying Suwon is a pile-supported helium balloon that goes up to 150 meters in the air.

#### Suwon Hwaseong Bicycle Taxi (Stop: Hwaseong Haenggung Palace Plaza/Hwahongmun Gate/ Yeonmudae)

Suwon Hwaseong Bicycle Taxi is a two-seater electric bicycle taxi. This eco-friendly means of transportation is great for touring Eco Mobility Village and Haenggung-dong.

Suwon Hwaseong Fortress

Suwon was called the "second capital" during the Joseon Dynasty, and the fortress stands at the center of the city. The fortress was built by King Jeongjo, the 22nd monarch of the Joseon Dynasty. Elegant and majestic, it is an architecture that stands out as exceptionally unique in the history of Korean fortress construction. It was named a UNESCO World Heritage site in December 1997.

Four main gates

Janganmun / Palldalmun / Hwaso Gate / Changnyongmun

There are four main gates in the Suwon Hwaseong Fortress Zone. Janganmun Gate's name means "the wellbeing and comfort of people," and Palldalmun Gate (National Treasure No. 402) "opening paths to all directions." Hwaso Gate (National Treasure No. 403) is connected to Seobuk Gongsindom and defended the western side of the fortress. Changnyongmun is named "to mean" "entrusted with the protection of the eastern sector of Hwaseong Fortress." The four gates are the fortress's key areas to tour and boast high architectural value.

**Gongsindom**

Gongsindom is a watchtower for observing remote locations. King Jeongjo showed great satisfaction in this structure by telling his subjects, "this is the first watchtower to be built in the country. Look around for as much as you like." Gongsindom is a must-see site for its high architectural beauty. The fortress has Dongbuk Gongsindom and Seobuk Gongsindom (National Treasure No. 1710).

**Hwahongmun Gate (Buksumun, Northern Floodgate)**

In the Joseon Dynasty, Suwoncheon Stream was called Beedeuna, which passed through the fortress. Water entered the fortress through Hwahongmun Gate. The stirring spray of water spilling from the seven arches is in great harmony with the surrounding landscape, making Hwahongmun Gate one of the Eight Scenic Wonders of Suwon.

**Banghwasuryujeong (Donksumun, Northeast Pavilion)**

Located at a strategic location amidst gorgeous surrounding landscape, the outward-protruding Dongbukgungu Pavilion (National Treasure No. 1709) is one of the most beautiful structures in the Hwaseong Fortress Zone. In fact, the name Banghwasuryujeong (National Treasure No. 1709) means "beautiful pavilion."

Sightseeing around the Suwon Hwaseong Fortress

Eco Mobility Village

MAP D4

Located in Haengung-dong, Eco Mobility Village was selected in September 2013 as a demonstration village of the Eco-Mobility Suwon 2013 campaign, and then developed into an eco-mobility village. Every alley in the village has much to see, and thus the village has the title called "Traveling the King's Alleys in Haengung-dong." Major specialties include the "Old Street with Stories," "Old Street of Rha Hye-suk" and "Birthplace of Rha Hye-suk."

**Traditional markets of Suwon Hwaseong Fortress**

Of the many traditional markets in the Suwon Hwaseong Fortress Zone, Palldalmun is referred to as the "Ying-made market" with centuries of history and tradition. Yeongdong Market is famous for selling hanbok (traditional Korean costumes), while the markets of Jidong, Minariwang and Mogol offer agricultural and livestock products, and other foods. The 28 Young Mall, newly opened in Yeongdong Market, continues to attract a large group of tourists.

**Gwanggyo Mountain & Gwanggyo Reservoir**

Gwanggyosan Mountain is one of the Eight Scenic Wonders of Suwon. The mountain is a habitat for fireflies, an indication of the clean environment in the area. With gentle ridges and thick tree forests, the mountain is an excellent place for a green shower and hiking. There are ten hiking trails, and Gwanggyo Reservoir is nearby.

**Gwanggyo Lake Park**

**Bongnyeongs Temple**

Located at the foot of Gwanggyosan Mountain, Bongnyeongs is one of the oldest traditional Buddhist temples in Suwon. It was founded by Monk Wongakusa in 1208, the fourth year of King Huijong's reign in the Goryeo Dynasty. See a stone statue of the Buddha Triad from the Goryeo era and the Sinyung portrait of the Buddha from the late Joseon period.

**Suwon beef ribs**

Initiated by Hwachunok restaurant on Sajaeon Street in Yeongdong Market in the 1940s, Suwon beef ribs were designated a unique local dish of Suwon in 1985. Compared to those in other areas, Suwon beef ribs are king-sized ribs seasoned with salt before grilling. Many beef rib restaurants are located in Yeongdong Market, Nosing Zone (Imok-dong) and the area between Dongsuwon Sajeon and Suwon IC.
