



Suwon Hwaseong Fortress |

Suwon was called the "second capital" during the Joseon Dynasty, and the fortress stands at the center of the city. The fortress was built by King Jeongjo, the 22nd monarch of the Joseon Dynasty. Elegant and majestic, it is an architecture that stands out as exceptionally unique in the history of Korean fortress construction. It was named a UNESCO World Heritage site in December 1997.







There are four main gates in the Suwon Hwaseong Fortress Zone. Janganmun Gate's name means "the wellbeing and comfort of people," and Paldalmun Gate (National Treasure No. 402) opening paths to all directions." Hwaseomun Gate (National Treasure No. 403) is connected to Seobuk Gongsimdon and defended the western side of the fortress. Changnyongmun is named to mean "entrusted with the protection of the eastern section of Hwaseong Fortress." The four gates are the fortress's key areas to tour and boast high architectural value.



It was founded by Monk Wongakguksa in 1208, the fourth year of King Huijong's reign in the Goryeo Dynasty. 




